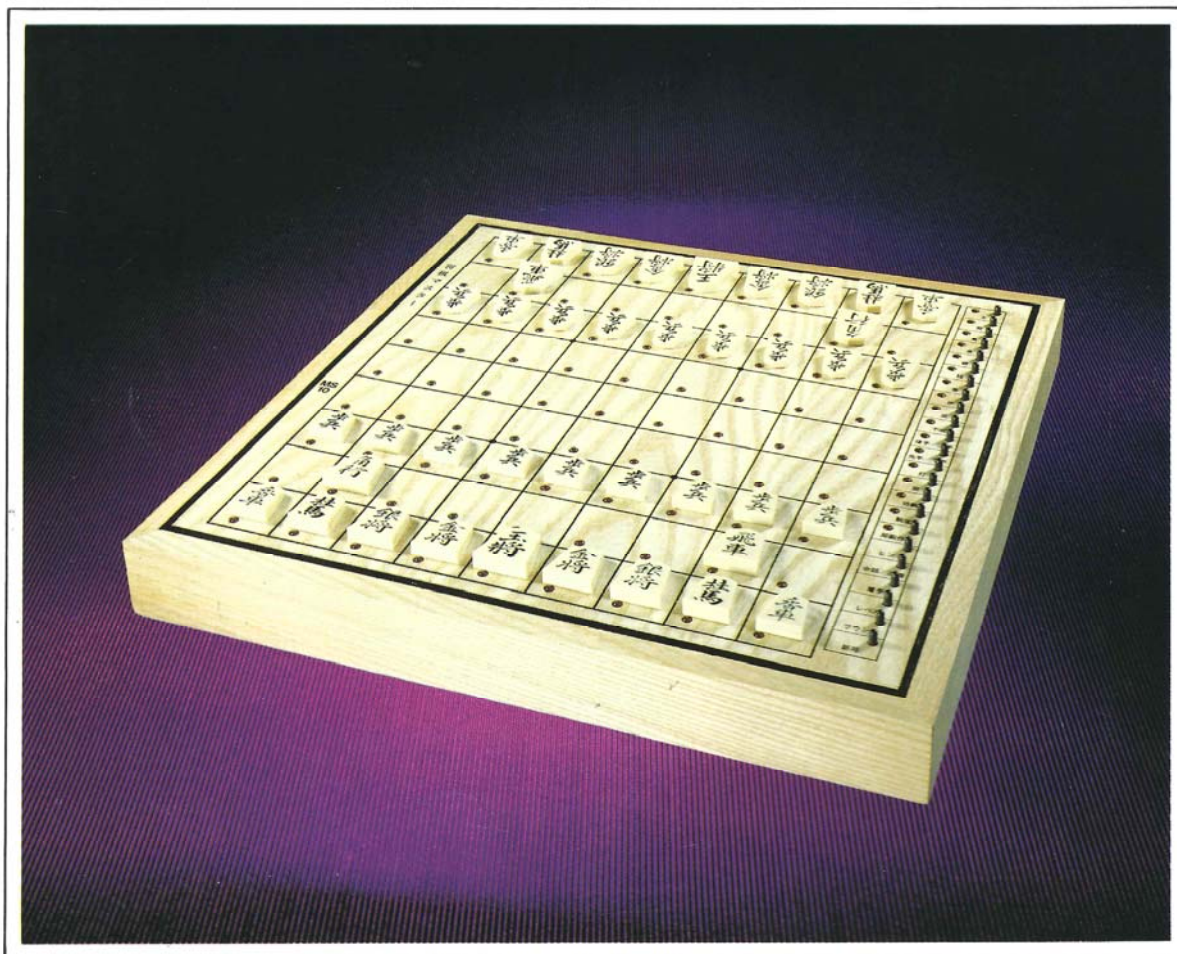


## 08-1987 [A-1696] Chess King - Shogi Master

Shogi is een Japans schaakspel. Op de Neurenbergse speelgoedbeurs in Duitsland werd zonder enige prijsopgave een Chess King Shogi Master aangekondigd. Ik ken dit spel niet, maar deze computer ziet er waanzinnig mooi uit!



### Shogi Master

- Programmed in collaboration with the Shogi Association.
- Auto-response, wooden Shogi Board uses magnetic pieces.
- Follows all the rules of Shogi including promotion and drops.
- Can play either side and can switch sides during a game.
- Takeback feature allows the user to retract moves, if necessary as far back as the start of the game.
- 8 playing levels, ranging from 15 seconds per move to 8 minutes per move, and an "infinite" level which allows the computer to think until interrupted.
- "Next Best Move" feature allows the user to see the best alternative moves found by the computer.
- Hint mode advises the user what to play.
- Position setup and verify features are easy to operate.
- Solves "Tsume Mate" problems up to Mate in 15.
- Plays standard Shogi openings.
